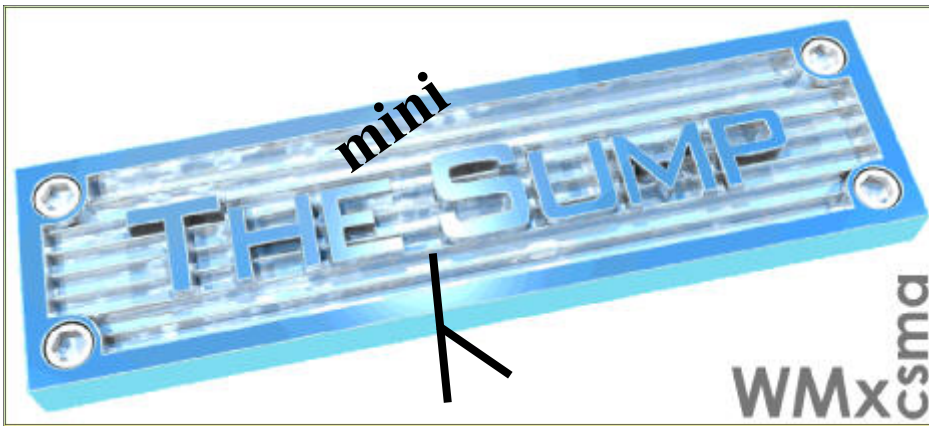

It is with great sadness I have to record the passing of a dear friend and colleague, and very long-time West Middlesex group member, Charlie Turner. After almost a month in hospital he died just before his 78th birthday.

Everyone in our Group will have met & known Charlie at sometime throughout his very long association with CSMA. He was certainly the most Senior 'active' member of West Middlesex Group having been a member for 59 years. He began his motor-sporting career on two wheels, a life-long passion that began with his motorcycling activities in the Army. A regular Competitor and Marshal on Trials all over the country, he had many successes before turning his hand to car rallies in the early 60's.

He, along with Dave Wiles, also had the role of 'Food Crew' to the CSMA's RAC Rally Team in the 1970's, towing a suitably equipped trailer behind his every-day road car & setting up in Service Areas & lay bys to feed the Crews & Mechanics in the Club's three-car Team. Charlie was also a regular supporter of several West Middlesex Group competitors, particularly Bob Head, for whom he acted as Service Crew for nearly 20 years on rallies all over the UK and in Ireland.

I think it was Jack Hyles who first introduced me to Charlie in 1963 at a WMx Clubnight at our then meeting place at Heathrow Airport and, shortly afterwards, we almost literally, bumped into each other in the bleak mid-winter of '63. It was in the middle of the night on the perimeter track of some remote airfield north of Great Dunmow, in properly deep snow (!), when we were each contesting a CSMA road rally. He was with long-time navigator Eddie Garner & I had Len Hillier with me, and we both managed to go off at the same icy corner. Despite our best joint efforts, both cars remained stuck fast until the Course-Closing Landrover came along an hour or so later. A friendship was formed that night and forty five years later Charlie & I still enjoyed putting the World to right & reminiscing about the good old days of Ariel's and Matchless's, Simca's, Skoda's, Fiesta's, and the last rally car Charlie had, a wonderful Hillman Hunter. This latter car was bought by Gordon Jarvis of Reading who has painstakingly converted it into a perfect replica of the 1967 London to Sydney Marathon winning car – I arranged for Charlie to see the car after its transformation – he was absolutely delighted with its re-incarnation!

Over the last twenty years or so he & I also spent many hours together Marshalling on various Motorcycle events including the CSMA's Services & Red Tape Trials. On one of these occasions, in 2005, Charlie announced to me that he'd like to present the West Middlesex Group with a Trophy to be awarded annually, in his name, to the Group's top Motorcyclist each year. This he did and a splendid curved-plate glass award bearing the title 'The Charlie Turner Trophy' with an action picture of him on his old Army Trials 'bike, in gold leaf, has been a proud addition to the Trophy table at the Group's Annual Dinner & Awards Evening in March every year since.

Charlie was very proud of his career with the Post Office, his lengthy service in the Army, and gave life-long support to CSMA following his love of motoring & motorcycling. Just two days short of his 78th birthday, he was lost to us on December 28th 2008 after suffering a number of health challenges over the past few years. To his family and his many friends I extend the very sincerest condolences of all of us in CSMA, but in particular from all of us in the West Middlesex Group.

Charlie, you were a true gentleman – God Bless you my friend.

If a committee cannot be formed, the future looks quite bleak. We may be able to re-form with members of other, previously disbanded, local groups, but that would almost certainly involve a change of name, so that WMx would be lost forever.

The WMx group has always been a very active group, yet recently it has been difficult to recruit members to the committee (hence Jez having to perform several duties).

However, it is very rewarding and now that the CSMA has 're-invented' itself, not too demanding of time. So, NOW IS the time to come forward and join us in helping to carry the group onto even better things.

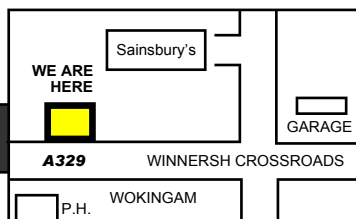
